



Information on the results XII International Forum “Innovative Development through the Intellectual Property Market”

On 30 October 2020 the XII International Forum “Innovative Development through the Intellectual Property Market” was held in Moscow (on the basis of Kutafin Moscow State Law University (MSAL)), which participants represented WIPO, SCO, Executive Committee and Euro-Asian Council for standardization, metrology and certification of the CIS, Eurasian Economic Commission of the EEU, Union State, state authorities, institutions of science and education, business and public organizations, mass media of 17 countries, including all CIS member states and EAEU, India, USA, China and Japan, 35 regions of Russia, including via videoconference on the regional sites (on the basis of the Ural State Economic University, Yekaterinburg, Kazan (Volga region) Federal University, Kazan). The online mode of the Forum’s video broadcast on MSAL’s website allowed an almost unlimited circle of interested participants to take part in its work, both in Russia and abroad.

The Forum Organizers included the Executive Committee of the CIS and Eurasian Economic Commission of the EAEU, The Russian Academy of Sciences, Intellectual Property Corporation RSRIIP, Association of Lawyers of Russia *with the support of the Russian Foundation for Basic Research (RFBR grant № 20-014-22008)*, WIPO, Ministry of International Affairs of Russia, Rossotrudnichestvo, Board of the Military-Industrial Commission of the Russian Federation, the Federal Antimonopoly Service of Russia. All these years, *the Directorate and Sponsor of the Forum* is the Republican Scientific Research Institute of Intellectual Property (RSRIIP), the only scientific non-profit organization in the EAEU and CIS countries that specializes in intellectual property and provides services in this area at the level of international ISO standards.

The main *information partners* of the Forum include “Mir” TV company, “National News Service” Information Agency (NSN), “Delovoy Express” Publishing House, “Intellectual Property Law”, “Russian Competition Law and Economics” and “Information Law” journals.

In his greetings to the Forum participants, Russian Prime Minister **Mikhail Mishustin** expressed confidence that the recommendations developed during the Forum “will help to find ways to solve important problems and will serve for further mutually beneficial cooperation between our countries”.

At the Forum’s opening, its participants were greeted by **Stepashin S.V.** – Chairman of the Program Committee of the Forum, Chairman of the Supervisory Board of RSRIIP, Co-Chairman of the Association of Lawyers of Russia; **Blazheev V.V.**, Rector of the Kutafin Moscow State Law University (MSAL), co-chairman of the Association of Lawyers of Russia; **Bochkarev O.I.** – Deputy Chairman of the Board of the Military-Industrial Commission of the Russian Federation. **Stepashin S.V.**, who opened the first forum in 2008, noted in his greeting that given the consequences of the pandemic, “we are again at the beginning of the road. None of the key indicators of the Strategy and the program of innovative development have been achieved by 2020. The objectives of the harmonization of legislation on intellectual property in the EAEU have not been resolved over the past five years. We understand that the Union will be created when there are single common markets for goods, works, services, finance and a single market for intellectual property. All constituent markets need a very strong component associated with an intellectual property economy and creating a competitive environment for other markets. If we do not understand this obvious truth, which has long been understood abroad, especially in the digital economy, then we will lose”.

Two plenary meetings and five specialized in-session meetings took place within the framework of the Forum, during which nearly 250 participants (subject to pandemic restrictions, 40 – in person,

the rest – remotely via Zoom), representing 5 science academies and 7 academic institutions, 24 universities, 9 ministries and departments of the Russian Federation, 26 main state corporations and holdings, half of them – scientists, including 8 academicians of the state science academies, 33 doctors of science and 47 candidates of science in the various scientific fields. More than 70 scientific reports were presented during the Forum.

During the plenary meeting **“The Eurasian Intellectual Property Market: Priorities and Prospects for 2030”** the main report “Digitalization, standardization and the intellectual property market as conditions for competitiveness in the framework of Eurasian integration” was presented by **Lopatin V.N.** - scientific director of RSRIIP, chairman of the Intergovernmental and National Technical committees on standardization “Intellectual property” (ITC 550), Expert of the Russian Academy of Sciences, Honored Science Worker of the Russian Federation. In his report, he presented the main provisions and conclusions of the annual scientific report of the RSRIIP “On the state of legal protection, use and protection of intellectual property in the EAEU and CIS countries in 2019 and the prospects for the Eurasian intellectual property market for the period up to 2030”.

At session No. 2 “Intellectual property and competitiveness of enterprises in attracting investments and diversifying production: key performance indicators (industry and corporate level)” (moderated by **Bochkarev O.I.** – Deputy Chairman of the Board of the Military-Industrial Commission of the Russian Federation; **Golobokova G.M.**, Head of the Research Department of Innovative Problems of Intellectual Property RSRIIP, Doctor of Economics) the main reports were presented by: **Chaikovskaya L.A.**, Professor of the Department of Accounting and Taxation of the Plekhanov Russian University of Economics, Doctor of Economics; **Ananyev S.P.**, Head of

At session No. 3 “Intellectual property and anti-corruption in public procurement in the R&D field” (moderated by *Astanin V.V.*, Head of the Research Department of Legislation and Comparative Intellectual Property Law, RSRIIP, Doctor of Law; *Bozhieva T.A.*, Head of the Inspectorate for Innovative Development of the Accounts Chamber of the Russian Federation), priority was given to a professional discussion with the participation of representatives of the control and accounting bodies regarding the draft recommendations “Corruption risks and typical corruption models in the field of public procurement for R&D and their prevention (government customer / fund – main contractor – corporation – a company with state participation – contractor)”, on the basis of which the standard will be developed. The main reports were presented by *Astanin V.V.* and *Doroshkov V.V.*, Chief Researcher of the Research Department of Legal Protection of Intellectual Property of the RSRIIP, Professor of the Department of Criminal Law, Criminal Procedure and Criminalistics of MGIMO (University), Doctor of Law, Corresponding Member of the Russian Academy of Education.

The priorities in the discussion were given to the generalization of the practice of voluntary application of GOST R 58223-2018 “Intellectual property. Antimonopoly regulation and protection against unfair competition” and the prospects for the development of an interstate Eurasian standard on its basis, as well as professional discussion of the draft concept of GOST “Intellectual property. Determination of the level of counterfeit goods at the regional level”.

At the session No. 5 “Artificial Intelligence and Personnel for the Intellectual Property Market” (moderated by *Grishina O.A.*, Head of the Department of Finance and Prices of the Plekhanov Russian University of Economics, Doctor of Economics and *Fedorov M. V.* – Rector of the Eurasian network online university, Deputy Secretary General of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly, Doctor of Economics, Doctor of Geological and Mineralogical Sciences), 13 reports and speeches were made, the main reports were presented by the moderators: *Fedorov M.V.* – “Migration, labor market and personnel training – priorities of Eurasian integration” and *Grishina O.A.* – “Innovative motivation and balance of interests of authors and copyright holders as a condition for the competitiveness of products”, as well as *Sachdeva Ravi*, Executive director of ADT (India); *Kovriga A.V.*, Vice President of the Association of Education and Science Managers (Ukraine); *Stern L.M.*,

President of the International Shukhov Foundation; *Zenin I.A.*, Head of the Research Department of Legal Protection of Intellectual Property, RSRIIP, Doctor of Law, Honored Professor of Lomonosov Moscow State University; *Stankevich O.G.*, Scientific Secretary of the National Center for Legislation and Legal Research of the Republic of Belarus; *Stoppe A.G.*, Head of the Department of the Organizational and Analytical Department of the Standing Committee of the Union State, professor at MGIMO and the Diplomatic Academy of the Russian Foreign Ministry; *Severin V.A.*, Professor of Lomonosov Moscow State University, Doctor of Law; *Yurteev V.Ya.*, First Vice-President – Co-Chairman of the Board of the National Technological Chamber, Chairman of the VOIR Committee for Prospective Development; *Fedorov M.V.*, Director of the Institute of Social Problems of the Peoples' Friendship University of Russia, Candidate of Legal Sciences; *Nechepurenko Yu.V.*, Head of the Scientific and Innovation Department of the Scientific Research Institute of Physical and Chemical Problems of the Belarusian State University, Candidate of Chemical Sciences; *Smirnov Yu.N.*, Head of the Department of Engineering Cybernetics and Director of the Department of Digital Technologies of Kazan State Power Engineering University, Candidate of Physical and Mathematical Sciences.

The results of the discussion of topical issues during the sessions on the Forum were presented by their moderators at the final plenary session, where participants gave public recognition to the heads of international organizations and state authorities of Russia, the EAEU for their greetings and attention to the work of the Forum, as well as to the Council of the Russian Foundation for Basic Research, Rossotrudnichestvo and MSAL for its support.

Following the discussion, the Forum participants unanimously adopted the **final document - Forum recommendations**, tentatively approved at an expanded meeting of the Supervisory and Academic Councils of RSRIIP with the participation of members of the Forum Program Committee.

As part of the Forum's business program, the Agreement on the organization of innovative cooperation on intellectual property issues was signed between the Institute of State and Law of the Russian Academy of Sciences and RSRIIP.

In general, according to Lebedev S.N., the Chairman of the Executive Committee – Executive Secretary of the CIS, “the results of the International Forum will make a practical contribution to the development of a common innovation space”.
